COVID-19 Vaccine Info

For those of you who are interested in receiving the COVID-19 vaccine, here are some things you may find helpful.

Scheduling for the vaccine is currently available to:

- Healthcare workers (including students and volunteers) with direct or indirect contact to patients or infectious materials
- All staff essential to the functioning of a healthcare system
- · Long-term care residents and staff
- · People age 65 and older
- First responders (firefighters, police, conservation officers, inspectors)
- Pre-K through high school staff and childcare workers
- · Corrections staff
- Workers in homeless shelters, congregate childcare institutions and adult and child protective services

Appointments are required to receive the vaccination. You will receive two doses of the vaccine, 14 days apart. To make an appointment, you can go to your county's website, and follow the COVID -19 link. An email was also sent out this week with links directly to the applications. If you do not have access to the internet, you can call 616-326-6992.

If you have any questions or concerns, or would like to discuss your decision of whether or not to receive the vaccine, feel free to reach out to Pastor Wayne.
